## **Technical information**

Clayworks plasters are our very own blend of clays and sands. They contain no chemical additives, are 100% non-toxic and 100% biodegradable.

A 25kg bag of plaster will cover approximately 7-8 m<sup>2</sup> at a thickness of 2-3mm.

A one tonne bag will cover approximately 320 m<sup>2</sup>.



### Where to use them

Clayworks pigmented clay plaster can be used on interior walls and ceilings. They can be applied directly onto most conventional building substrates with the use of a suitable primer (please see Clayworks clay plaster guidance notes). They are suited alike to historic and eco-walling substrates such as cob, lime, hemp, strawbale and breathable walling boards.

Our pigmented clay plasters are through-pigmented, so no need to paint! However, if you'd prefer a colour we don't offer, then choose a micro-porous finish, such as clay paint or limewash.

The carefully blended ingredients give our plasters a unique depth and subtle radiance, which is difficult to achieve with other plasters and paints.



# Why use them

Clay plasters are naturally beautiful and have been used since ancient times. And if that wasn't enough, they have a host of other benefits too.


